In light of the flurry of motions filed by the parties in the last few days, I thought it might be advisable to summarize any outstanding motions and the schedule for this Monday morning.

There are, to my knowledge, three motions still awaiting rulings from the Court. Those are the Plaintiff's Motion *In Limine* to Preclude Dr. Blumberg from Presenting Hearsay Evidence (Paper No. 154), Plaintiff's Motion *In Limine* requesting that "No Jurors be Stricken Because of Defendants' Activities on October 20 and 21, 2007" relating to the Defendant's news release apparently indicating their intent to protest at several Maryland churches this weekend (Paper No. 174), and Plaintiff's Motion *In Limine* with respect to a series of exhibits which have been listed by the Defendants (Paper No. 179).
