Allow this letter to clarify the recent electronic filings by the Defendants. On July 20, 2011, our office filed a Motion to Dismiss Due to Insufficient Service of Process (Document 6). This Motion was intended to be filed on behalf of Defendants Shelton and McCoy as reflected in the Motion and memorandum. During the electronic filing of the motion, Defendant Justia, Inc. was accidentally listed as another defendant filing the Motion. Please correct this, so that the Motion is only filed by Defendants Shelton and McCoy. Also, the Plaintiff responded to this Motion and properly served both Defendants. Accordingly, we wish to withdraw this Motion as moot.

The two other motions to dismiss are filed as intended. On August 19, 2011, we filed a Motion to Dismiss Due to Insufficient Service of Process on behalf of Defendant Justia, Inc. (Document 10).
