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**MEMORANDUM**

Defendant has filed a partial motion to dismiss. The motion (document 6) will be granted. Plaintiff apparently does not challenge defendant's contention that counts 5 and 6 did not state claims upon which relief could be granted. I agree that the defendant's motion appears meritorious. Accordingly, counts 5 and 6 are dismissed.

Plaintiff was required to file her discrimination charge on or before June 29, 2015. She did not do so. She did attempt to file a state court action alleging employment discrimination on June 15, 2015, but she did not pay the filing fee.
