Follow-up requested by Scott Collen on Friday, 8/19/05, as a result of a phone call received by a temporary Lead substituting for Mike Turner (out due to health reasons) from Victor Ruiz.

I interviewed Victor Ruiz, Grisel Nunez, Alphonso Sutton, Fernando Holquin, Emetem Nkwetta (known as Blythe, who was too afraid to talk at the facility and called me the next day on her cell), the latter two having gone over to Blockbuster's employ. Victor, Grisel and Emetem all said the following:

TAJ threatens, yells and treats the African Blacks and Hispanics differently than the American Blacks; i.e., allows the latter to talk while the others cannot, take longer lunch hours and treats them with the respect he does not give to the others.

TAJ directs them by telling them Linc has told him to give them certain directives.

TAJ, according to all three, was having an affair with Takara Hughes-Martin until Takara left for Florida to be with her husband who has been transferred there. Grisel said they were seen in the office on Sundays having sex as people looked through the slats in the blinds. She also said they took 1 1/2 hour lunches together outside of the office. All said that TAJ looks the woman up and down in a sexual way, and that the women wear long shirts to cover their behinds for that reason.

TAJ, according to Emetem, was previously in a sexual affair with Yasmina Assoumanou (also known as Sarah) until he started with Takara. She says he now treats Assoumanou very badly.

When I first arrived, TAJ and Linc were in Linc's office; I asked if Takara had left for Florida, since I had not been notified of her last day. TAJ & Linc replied that she was going to return in about 3 weeks and would be working for them again.

Fernando Holquin and Alphonso Sutton both said things were all right and that they saw nothing out of the ordinary. All except Alphonso indicated they feared to speak out because they did not want to lose their jobs.
