After due consideration of the above entitled case, it is determined that the claimant sustained an accidental injury or occupational disease/illness as defined in Section 9-101 (b) or (g), Labor and Employment Article, Maryland Annotated Code, arising out of and in the course of employment on 11/02/2015 that the average weekly wage was \$459.44 and that the claimant was temporarily totally disabled as a result of said injuries.

The Commission has concluded to pass an ORDER based on the evidence in the record, but will reserve the right of both parties to have the issue of average weekly wage Adjudicated at the first hearing before the Commission.






Charles County Public Schools will open for students for three days during spring break -Monday, March 30; Tucsday, March 31; and Wednesday, April 1. Wednesday, April 1 will be a two-hour early dismissal day for students and afternoon prekindergarten students attend that day. The school system has used seven inclement weather days so far this school year, of which only four arc built into the school calendar. The use of spring break days for lost instructional time is outlined in the Charles County Public Schools Parent Handbook/Calendar annually.

Schools will be closed for spring break April 2-6, and reopen on Tuesday, April 7. Maryland law requires school to operate 180 days for students each school year. The school system builds four inclement weather days into its calendar each year, which are deleted from the end of the year if not used. All days have been used this school year, making Tuesday, June 16 the last day of school for students.
