STATEMENT OF RELEVANT FACT TO QUESTION NUMBER FOUR

The California Bar placed me on a temporary administrative suspension for nonpayment of dues from July 1, 2016 to January 31, 2016. The nonpayment of dues was a result of a miscommunication between me and my employer, Munger Tolles & Olson, following my departure from the firm in 2016.

On January 31, 2016, I was reinstated to active status by the Supreme Court of California upon payment of all State bar fees and penalties. Since January 31, 2016, and at present, I have been and remain an active member of the State Bar of California. *See* attached Certificate of Good Standing dated January 31, 2016.
