I write in response to your letter of June 21, 2011. As you are aware, many of the materials that you have requested are covered by protective orders issued by the United States District Court for the District of Massachusetts in the above-referenced matters. The parties to those protective orders include Facebook, and we understand that Facebook has objected to its confidential documents being provided to new counsel for the Founders. Given Facebook's position and the posture of the above-referenced cases, Finnegan requests that you obtain court authorization for your firm to receive any of the confidential or sealed materials that you seek.

With respect to materials that are not sealed, confidential or otherwise protected from disclosure, I note that Finnegan has previously provided successor counsel for the Founders, including Quinn Emanuel Urquhart & Sullivan LLP, with a copy of almost all of these documents.
