Mr. Beauregard -

Your self-serving and one-sided accusations are unfounded and unwarranted. Your clients have transferred public monies donated for the benefit of the Wareham Free Public Library to private corporations, including the Foundation and the Friends. The Friends then allocated the money to the Spinney Library, which is not affiliated with the Wareham Free Public Library. As such, both were named in the counterclaims. If these corporations were not named the Town would have no ability to recoup the funds taken from it.

You received notice of the counterclaims many weeks ago and this should be no surprise to you. Additionally, please note that Federal Rule 4 provides for the imposition of costs and attorneys fees if good cause is not provided for accepting service. You need only review the Rule to see that this is not language or sanctions that I created.

Finally, I would note that almost all of my correspondence directed to you expresses hope of resolving this matter through an informal process, such as mediation. My efforts to resolve this process through settlement, rather than litigation, have been ignored by you and your clients. This lawsuit, which I am sure you would characterize as "aggressive and hostile," was filed by your clients, not the Town. We have responded appropriately. While it is unfortunate that you have focused your efforts on attacking our representation of our client, rather than the merits, or lack thereof, of your clients' position, I will not respond in kind by expressing my thoughts on your representation of your client, the tactics you have employed or the lack of professionalism you have demonstrated during this unfortunate matter.

Please note, I have no problem with including Attorney Kopelman on our correspondence. I can assure you that doing so will not diminish our advocacy for our client.
