On April 6, 2012, petitioner filed <u>Petitioner's Notice of Appeal and Application for a</u> <u>Certificate of Appealability</u> [#48] of the denial of his habeas petition. A certificate of appealability will issue "only if the applicant has made a substantial showing of the denial of a constitutional right."¹ The applicant "must demonstrate that reasonable jurists would find the district court's assessment of the constitutional claim debatable or wrong."²

Here, upon review of the submissions of Petitioner, this court finds that he has not made the requisite showing with respect to the alleged denial of his constitutional rights. Accordingly, <u>Petitioner's Notice of Appeal and Application for a Certificate of Appealability</u> is DENIED. The Clerk shall transmit this <u>Order</u> to the First Circuit Court of Appeals.
