Having allowed <u>Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment</u> [#25], this court hereby enters the following judgment in this action:

- 1. This court declares that Section 3 of the Defense of Marriage Act, 1 U.S.C. § 7, is unconstitutional as applied to Plaintiffs.
- Defendants are enjoined from discriminating against Plaintiffs by treating them differently from similarly situated individuals who are married to persons of the opposite sex.
- 3. Defendant Michael J. Astrue shall review the applications for Social Security

 Benefits of Plaintiffs Jo Ann Whitehead, Randy Lewis-Kendell, and Herb Burtis,

 without regard to Section 3 of the Defense of Marriage Act, 1 U.S.C. § 7.
