DECLARATION

I, Virginia Aboso, declare and state as follows:

1. I make this declaration of my own knowledge.
2. I reside in an apartment at 11204 Chestnut West, Randolph, MA 02368. The apartment building is locked so that, in order to gain access into the building, a person needs a key to open the door or a person must be buzzed in by someone inside the building.
3. In or around mid to late September 2011, two women knocked on the door of my apartment. I do not know how they gained entry into the apartment building. My son, who is a minor, answered my apartment door. I was not at home at the time and my son was not accompanied by an adult at the time. One of the women showed my son a photograph of a man. The women asked my son questions about the man in the

photograph. My son informed me that he was asked whether he had seen this man around and whether he knew him. My son told the women that he recognized the man in the photo as the man who lived upstairs in the same apartment building. Based on the women's questions, my son was left with the impression that the man in the photograph, who my son recognized as his neighbor, and who I understand is Jayme Gordon, had done something wrong.

4. I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
