I. INTRODUCTION

On June 10, 2011, a jury in the Massachusetts Superior Court for Middlesex County convicted petitioner Brian Racine ("Racine") of indecent assault and battery on a child under the age of 14. On June 16, 2011, Racine was also convicted following a bench trial of being a subsequent offender. Racine was sentenced to a term of 15 to 25 years in state prison and is currently serving that sentence. Pending before the court is his petition for habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254.
