Plaintiff Jason Schultz, who appears pro se, is a prisoner at Souza-Baranowski Correctional Center in Shirley, the Massachusetts. He seeks relief under 42 U.S.C. § 1983 based upon claims that several Massachusetts Department of Corrections ("DOC") officers violated his Eighth Amendment right to be free from cruel and unusual punishment when they used excessive force and a chemical agent to remove him from his cell. The defendants have moved for summary judgment and the motion has been referred to this court for a report and recommendation.
