## 05-74891 3D Systems, Inc. v. Envisiontec, Inc., et al

## A. Claim 11 of the '981 Patent

Claim 11 depends from claim 10 and limits the terms "medium" and "prescribed radiation" in claim 10 to a photopolymer and light, respectively. As limited, claim 11 is rewritten as follows, with disputed claim terms appearing in boldface:

- 11. (1) A method of **producing a three-dimensional object** from a [medium] <u>photopolymer</u> capable of selective physical transformation.
- (2) when **subjected to [prescribed radiation] light** said method comprising the steps of:
  - (3) providing said [medium] <u>photopolymer</u>:
  - (4) providing said [prescribed radiation] light;
- (5) providing data representing the three-dimensional object to be formed which was generated on CAD system;
  - (6) **forming a first cross sectional layer** of structure by
- (7) exposing said [medium] <u>photopolymer</u> to said [prescribed radiation] <u>light;</u>
- (8) **forming successive layers of [medium]** photopolymer adjacent to any
  - (9) **previously formed cross sectional layers** of structure
- (10) **forming and adhering successive cross sectional layers** of structure
  - (11) to any **previously formed cross-sectional layer** of structure
- (12) by <u>exposing said medium to said prescribed radiation in</u> <u>response to said data</u>
- (13) whereby a <u>plurality of adhered cross sectional layers of</u> structure form the three-dimensional object.
