**JUDGMENT**

This matter is pending before the Court on Petitioner's application for a writ of habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2254. Petitioner is challenging his 2005 convictions following a guilty plea in the Circuit Court for Washtenaw County, Michigan, for second-degree murder (Mich. Comp. Laws §750.317), felony firearm (Mich.
