ORDER TERMINATING PRIOR ORDER AND EXTENDING DISCOVERY

The court conducted a telephone conference, on the record, with counsel for Plaintiff and Defendants on November 19, 2008. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline for discovery is extended until December 15, 2008. All other dates contained in the court's July 23, 2008 scheduling order remain unchanged.
