**ORDER MEMORIALIZING DATES AND  
SUSPENDING COURT-SUPERVISED DISCOVERY**

On June 1, 2009, the court conducted a scheduling conference, on the record, with *pro se* Plaintiff Thomas M. Beaudoin and counsel for Defendants. During the conference, counsel for the state Defendants indicated that he anticipated filing a motion to dismiss by **June 12, 2009**. If counsel files a motion by such date, the local rules provide that Plaintiff will have until **July 7, 2009** to respond. If, however, upon receipt of the motion, Plaintiff desires additional time, he may so request by contacting the court's case manager, Lisa Wagner, at (313) 234-5522.<sup>1</sup> In the meantime, with the exception of Defendant Grant, the parties will suspend discovery pending resolution of the motion to dismiss. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that court-supervised discovery is SUSPENDED until further order of the court<sup>2</sup> with the exception of discovery regarding Plaintiff's claims against Defendant Grant.

<sup>1</sup>The court is inclined to grant Plaintiff additional time, within reasonable limitations.

<sup>2</sup>The parties are free to engage in voluntary discovery by agreement.

The court will determine whether a hearing on the anticipated motion to dismiss is necessary after receiving Plaintiff's response. See E.D. Mich. LR 7.1(e)(2).
