## ORDER DENYING PETITIONER'S MOTIONS FOR EQUITABLE TOLLING AND TO SUPPLEMENT

At a session of said Court, held in the U.S. District Courthouse, Eastern District of Michigan on July 1, 2009.

PRESENT: HONORABLE PATRICK J. DUGGAN U.S. DISTRICT COURT JUDGE

This matter is before the Court on Petitioner's motion for equitable tolling to allow him to proceed on his petition for writ of habeas corpus as timely filed under the one-year statute of limitations applicable to federal habeas actions, as well as his motion to supplement that pleading with a psychological report (which he has not attached).
