**OPINION AND ORDER (1) ADOPTING THE MAGISTRATE JUDGE'S REPORT AND
RECOMMENDATION;
(2) GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR ATTORNEY FEES (Dkt. No. 76), AND
(3) DENYING AS MOOT PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO REVIEW AMENDED TAXED
BILL OF COSTS (Dkt. No. 81)**

Before the Court is Magistrate Judge R. Steven Whalen's Report and Recommendation Re: Attorney Fees (Dkt. No. 90), and Report and Recommendation Re: Taxable Costs (Dkt. No. 91). Both documents were filed on January 27, 2012. The Magistrate Judge has recommended granting Plaintiff's Motion for Attorney Fees and awarding \$103,401.96 in cost and attorney fees, as well as \$1 in nominal damages.¹ The Magistrate Judge has further recommended denying Plaintiff's Motion to Review Amended Taxed Bill of Costs as moot.


Having reviewed that Report and Recommendation, and there being no timely objections from either party under 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1) and E.D. Mich L.R. 72.1(d), the Court **ADOPTS** both

of the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendations, **GRANTS** Plaintiff's Motion for Attorneys' Fees, Costs, Expenses and Nominal Damages, and **DENIES AS MOOT** Plaintiff's Motion to Review Amended Taxed Bill of Costs.
