**GOVERNMENT'S PETITION
FOR TRANSFER OF DEFENDANT TO
ANOTHER DISTRICT AND SUPPORTING BRIEF**

Pursuant to Rule 5(c)(3)(D) of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure, the United States of America hereby petitions the Court for an order transferring defendant **CIPRIANO GRIMALDO-PACHECO** to answer to charges pending in another federal district, and states:

1. On **April 15, 2011**, defendant was arrested in the Eastern District of Michigan in connection with a federal arrest warrant issued in the **District of Nebraska - Omaha based on a Complaint**. Defendant is charged in that district with **Sale of a Social Security Card in violation of Title 42, United States Code Section 408(a)(7)(C)**.

2. Rule 5 requires this Court to determine whether defendant is the person named in the arrest warrant and is entitled to a preliminary examination as described in Paragraph One above. See Fed. R. Crim. P. 5(c)(3)(D)(ii).

WHEREFORE, the government request this Court to conduct transfer proceedings in accordance with Rule 5 of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure.
