ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO AMEND HABEAS PETITION

Petitioner Leonard Carter filed a petition for writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. Respondent has not yet filed a response to the petition. Before the Court is Petitioner's motion to file an amended petition.

Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 15 provides that the Court should freely allow a party to amend when justice so requires. FED. R. CIV. P. 15(a)(2). Accordingly, the Court **GRANTS** Petitioner's motion to amend his habeas petition.
