**ORDER GRANTING IN PART AND DENYING IN PART
DEFENDANTS' MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT**

This matter is presently before the Court on defendants' motion for summary judgment [docket entry 26]. Magistrate Judge Anthony P. Patti has submitted a Report and Recommendation ("R&R") in which he recommends that the motion be granted in part and denied in part.
