**ORDER**

On April 14, 2017, Plaintiff Morris Weatherspoon, a prison inmate in the custody of the Michigan Department of Corrections, filed a *pro se* civil complaint under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Before the Court is his Motion for a Victim Restitution Order under 18 U.S.C. § 3663 [Doc. #29].

The statute in question, 18 U.S.C. § 3663, is contained in the Federal Criminal Code, and provides that the Court may, when imposing a sentence on a criminal defendant, order restitution to a victim of the offense. The *civil* Defendants in this case have not been convicted of any crimes, and are not subject to criminal sentencing. 18 U.S.C. § 3663 has no application to this case.

Therefore, Plaintiff's motion [Doc. #29] is DENIED.
