FEBRUARY 23, 2022 REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION (ECF NO. 23);**

AND

**(2) SUA SPONTE DISMISSING PLAINTIFF'S CLAIMS AGAINST
UNNAMED JOHN DOE DEFENDANT WITHOUT PREJUDICE**

On February 23, 2022, Magistrate Judge Patricia T. Morris issued a Report and Recommendation to dismiss without prejudice Plaintiff Robbie Taylor's claims against the unnamed John Doe Defendant.
