- 3. Defendants shall file an Answer by May 31, 2024.

4. The parties may file omnibus motions for summary judgment by **June 20**,

2024. The combined motions and supporting briefs shall not exceed 60

pages.

5. The parties shall file responses to motions for summary judgment by <u>July</u>

11, 2024. The responses (inclusive of any supporting brief) shall not

exceed 60 pages.

6. The parties shall file replies in further support of their motions for

summary judgment by July 25, 2024.
