This matter is before the Court on Magistrate Judge Anthony P. Patti's March 22, 2018 Report and Recommendation (Dkt. 30), recommending that Plaintiff's Motion for Authorization of Attorney's Fees pursuant to 42 U.S.C. §406(b) (Dkt. 27) be GRANTED in part and DENIED in PART.

district court is not obligated to independently review the record.

See Thomas v. Arn, 474 U.S. 140, 149-52 (1985). The Court will

therefore accept the Magistrate's Report and Recommendation of

March 22, 2018 as this Court's findings of fact and conclusions of

law.

Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that Magistrate Judge

Patti's Report and Recommendation of March 22, 2018 is AC-

CEPTED and **ADOPTED**. It is **FURTHER ORDERED** that

Plaintiff's Motion for Attorney's Fees is **GRANTED** in part and

DENIED in part, and that Plaintiff receive a fee award of

\$9,514.00 per the Report and Recommendation.
