ORDER OF PARTIAL DISMISSAL

On July 12, 2011, Plaintiff filed a complaint alleging the following causes of action: Count I, false arrest/imprisonment; Count II, violation of 42 U.S.C. § 1983; Count III, municipal liability under § 1983; and Count IV, gross negligence.

Although alleged civil rights violations brought pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 are cognizable in this court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1331, the remaining allegations present claims based on state law. This court declines to exercise supplemental jurisdiction over the latter claims so as to avoid jury confusion. <u>See</u> 28 U.S.C. § 1367(c); <u>United Mine Workers v. Gibbs</u>, 383 U.S. 715 (1966); <u>Padilla v. City of Saginaw</u>, 867 F. Supp. 1309 (E.D. Mich. 1994).

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's gross negligence and false arrest/imprisonment claims, to the extent that they are based upon state law, are DISMISSED.
