## **ORDER OF PARTIAL DISMISSAL**

Plaintiff Gary L. Zimmer recently filed a two-count complaint in this court October 9, 2012, alleging retaliation in violation of federal law in Count I and retaliation in violation of Michigan law in Count II.

Although Plaintiff's cause of action arising under federal law is cognizable in this court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1331, the allegations presented in Count II are based solely on state law. This court declines to exercise supplemental jurisdiction over Plaintiff's state law claim in order to avoid jury confusion. <u>See</u> 28 U.S.C. § 1367(c); <u>United Mine Workers v. Gibbs</u>, 383 U.S. 715 (1966); and <u>Padilla v. City of Saginaw</u>, 867 F. Supp. 1309 (E.D. Mich. 1994).

Therefore, it is hereby **ORDERED** that Count II of the complaint is **DISMISSED**.
