ORDER

Pending before the Court is Plaintiff's October 16, 2009, Objection to the Report and Recommendation (Dkt 77), in which Plaintiff delineates various objections to the magistrate's report and recommendation.

The Magistrate Judge issued a Report and Recommendation on September 18, 2009, recommending that defendant's motion for summary judgment be granted and this action be dismissed (Dkt 74). Any objection to the report and recommendation must have been filed and served within ten (10) days of service of the report on the plaintiff. See 28 U.S.C. 636(b)(1)(C); Fed. R. Civ. P. 72(b). No timely objections were filed. This Court therefore entered an Opinion and Order approving and adopting the recommendation on October 9, 2009, and entered a Judgment dismissing the case (Dkt 75).
