**ORDER APPROVING AND ADOPTING
MAGISTRATE JUDGE’S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION**

On August 26, 2011, Magistrate Judge Joseph G. Scoville issued a Report and Recommendation (“R&R”) recommending that the Court affirm the final decision of the Commissioner of Social Security denying Plaintiff William Edward Lowe’s claim for disability insurance benefits and supplemental security income benefits.
