OPINION AND ORDER APPROVING AND ADOPTING MAGISTRATE JUDGE'S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

On March 18, 2014, Magistrate Judge Joseph G. Scoville issued a Report and Recommendation ("R&R") (Dkt. No.24) recommending that Plaintiff's claims against Defendant in his official capacity be dismissed with prejudice and that Defendant's motion for summary judgment on the remaining claims (Dkt. No. 12) be granted. No objections have been filed, and the deadline for doing so has expired. The Court has reviewed the matter and concludes that the R&R correctly analyzes the issues and makes a sound recommendation.

For the foregoing reasons, this Court adopts the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation as the Opinion of this Court. A Judgment will be entered consistent with this Opinion and Order. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 58. Because this action was filed in forma pauperis, this Court certifies, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(3), that an appeal of this decision would not be taken

The Clerk of the Court updated Plaintiff's address and re-mailed the R&R on March 24, 2014. in good faith. See McGore v. Wrigglesworth, 114 F.3d 601, 610 (6th Cir.1997).

Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Magistrate Judge's March 18, 2014, R&R (Dkt. No.

24) is **APPROVED** and **ADOPTED** as the opinion of the Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff's claims against Defendant in his official

capacity are **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant's motion for summary judgment (Dkt. No.

12) is **GRANTED**.

IT IS FURTHER CERTIFIED that an appeal of this decision would not be taken in good

faith.
