**ORDER APPROVING AND ADOPTING  
MAGISTRATE JUDGE’S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION**

On February 17, 2011, Magistrate Judge Timothy P. Greeley issued a Report and Recommendation (“R&R”) recommending that Plaintiff’s motion to compel (Dkt. No. 19) and motion to appoint counsel (Dkt. No. 43) be denied, that Defendant’s motion for summary judgment (Dkt. No. 25) be granted, and that this case be dismissed in its entirety. (Dkt. No. 44.) **IT IS FURTHER CERTIFIED** pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(3) that an appeal of this action would not be in good faith.
