## ORDER APPROVING AND ADOPTING MAGISTRATE JUDGE'S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

On January 16, 2014, Magistrate Judge Timothy Greeley issued a Report and Recommendation ("R&R") (Dkt. No. 16) recommending that the remaining Defendant's motion for summary judgment be granted and that this case be terminated in its entirety. The Court finds no good-faith basis for appeal within the meaning of 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(3). *See McGore v. Wrigglesworth*, 114 F.3d 601, 611 (6<sup>th</sup> Cir. 1997).
