This case is before the Court on the objections of American Medical Systems, Inc., and Laserscope (collectively, Plaintiffs) to an Order issued by the Honorable Franklin L. Noel, United States Magistrate Judge, on August 21, 2009, denying Plaintiffs' motion to compel or, in the alternative, for leave to supplement their claim charts. Laser Peripherals, LLC, responded to Plaintiffs' objections. Having reviewed the record, the Court affirms the magistrate judge's Order because it is neither "clearly erroneous" nor "contrary to law." *See* 28 U.S.C.
