Nos. 1 and 4) are **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.

LET JUDGMENT BE ENTERED ACCORDINGLY AS TO PLAINTIFF STANLEY HAYNES, DECEASED, BY AND THROUGH HIS SURVIVING SPOUSE VIVIAN HAYNES ONLY.
