**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED** as follows:

is hereby remanded to the USCIS for completion of the  
background investigations and adjudication of his application  
for adjustment of status as soon as practicable;


2. The USCIS shall report to the Court on the status of

4. Each party shall bear its own attorney's fees, costs, and disbursements herein.
