This matter is before the court upon petitioner Muhammad Akbar's ("Akbar") pro se objections to the November 13, 2009, report and recommendation of Magistrate Judge Susan Richard Nelson. The magistrate judge recommends dismissing Akbar's 28 U.S.C. § 2241 petition challenging the United States Parole Commission's designation of his case for original jurisdiction.¹ The court reviews the report and recommendation of the magistrate judge de novo. 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C); Fed. R. Civ. P. 72(b)(3); D. Minn. LR 72.2(b).

After a review of the file, record and proceedings herein, including the audio recording of Akbar's June 17, 2009, interim parole hearing [Doc. No. 7], the court finds that the report and recommendation of the magistrate judge is well reasoned and

correctly disposes of Akbar's petition. Therefore, the court overrules Akbar's objections.
