Wallin, or any other proper officer or employee of the Internal Revenue Service, and produce books, papers, records, or other data as is required and called for by the terms of the summons at such time and place as may be fixed by Revenue Officer Richard A. Wallin, or any other proper officer or employee of the Internal Revenue Service, but by no means later than May 28, 2010.
- 3. Petitioner may recover its costs in maintaining this action.

LET JUDGMENT BE ENTERED ACCORDINGLY.
