**AMENDED ORDER GRANTING
PLAINTIFFS' LEAD COUNSEL'S
MOTION TO WITHDRAW**

Plaintiffs' Lead Counsel previously filed a Motion to Withdraw in this action, seeking the withdrawal of retained counsel for Plaintiff Rachel Dostalek. The Court granted that Motion and ordered that Williams Kherkher Hart Boundas was no longer counsel of record for Plaintiff in this action. (See Doc. No. 15.)

The Court has subsequently discovered that Plaintiffs' Lead Counsel's Motion did not list all of the co-counsel identified for Plaintiff in the docket. As a result, the Court's Order did not expressly discharge Williams Kherkher Hart Boundas' co-counsel, as was intended by Plaintiffs' Lead Counsel's Motion and by the Court.

Based on the foregoing, and all the files, records, and proceedings herein, **IT IS ORDERED** that the Court's May 20, 2011 Order (Doc. No. 15) is **AMENDED** to clarify that *all* counsel of record are discharged from representing Plaintiff Rachel Dostalek in this action.
