Dear Judge Nelson:

I write as counsel for the Eller class of retired players and rookies in this matter.

Today, counsel for plaintiffs in the *Brady* case sent a letter to the Court. That letter accepts the Court's invitation that the parties use the offices of the federal court to resolve this dispute.

The *Eller* Plaintiffs wholeheartedly agree that the parties ought to use the interval before Your Honor issues any opinion to attempt to mediate their differences. Pursuant to Local Rule 83.13(a), Your Honor has the authority to appoint a mediator. If the Court wishes to consider that option, we have been advised that Kenneth Feinberg (no relation), the renowned mediator (see <a href="http://www.feinbergrozen.com/">http://www.feinbergrozen.com/</a>), is available to assist the Court and the parties. Of course, the *Eller* Plaintiffs would be willing to mediate before any magistrate judge or mediator whom Your Honor selects. Since time is of the essence we would be willing to meet at anytime, including as early as next week, to discuss this suggestion and/or proceed with mediation.
