This matter is before the court upon the report and recommendation of Magistrate Judge David T. Schultz dated March 1, 2018 (R&R). The magistrate judge recommended that the court (1) dismiss the federal constitutional claim with prejudice; (2) dismiss the remaining state-law claims without prejudice for lack of jurisdiction; and (3) deny the application to proceed in forma pauperis.
