This matter is before the Court on the December 14, 2020 Report and Recommendation (R&R) of United States Magistrate Judge Becky R. Thorson. (Dkt. 16.) No objections were filed. ORDERED:

1. The December 14, 2020 R&R, (Dkt. 16), is **ADOPTED**.
2. Defendant Andrew Saul's motion for summary judgement, (Dkt. 14), is

3. Plaintiff Elizabeth A. M.'s motion for summary judgement, (Dkt. 12), is

GRANTED IN PART to the extent that Plaintiff seeks remand for further proceedings.

4. This case is remanded to the Commissioner of Social Security for further proceedings pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g).
