<u>ORDER</u>

By Order (# 13) dated April 30, 2012, the court directed the claimant to show cause why this case should not be dismissed for her failure to file a brief in accordance with the court's earlier Order (# 10). On May 7, 2012, the claimant filed her response (# 15) along with her brief in support of the complaint (# 14).
