

ORDER MOOTING PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO PROCEED IFP

Presently before the Court is the Plaintiff's Motion to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis* [2]. Subsequent to the filing of her motion, the Plaintiff paid the requisite filing fee. Simultaneously, the Magistrate Judge assigned to this case entered a Report and Recommendation recommending that the Plaintiff's motion be denied and that she be granted a reasonable time to pay the filing fee [4]. Given that the Plaintiff has now paid the required filing fee, her motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* is now moot, as is the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation.
