SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER ON CERTIFICATION AND NOTICE

On February 27, 2019, the Court conditionally certified this collective action under the Fair Labor Standards Act. *See* Order [41]. Opt-in returns from prospective class members must be postmarked no more than sixty days from the date that the notices are mailed to be deemed timely for the purposes of joining this collective action. *See* Order [42]; *see also* Notice [47].
