**ORDER CLOSING CASE**

On November 17, 2017, the Court stayed this case pursuant to the automatic stay provided for under 11 U.S.C. § 362 because the defendants had initiated bankruptcy proceedings. Accordingly, **the Clerk of the Court is directed to administratively CLOSE this action.** See *Mire v. Full Spectrum Lending, Inc.*, 389 F.3d 163, 167 (5th Cir. 2004) (“The effect of an administrative closure is no different from a simple stay, except that it affects the count of active cases pending on the court's docket; i.e., administratively closed cases are not counted as active.”). Should further litigation be necessary, any party may move to reopen the case.
