ORDER

The Clerk of Court will serve by email (Return Receipt, High Importance) a copy of the petition, this order, acknowledgment of service of process form, and any other initial filings, upon Jim Hood, Attorney General of the State of Mississippi, or his lawful successor, to Assistant Attorneys General Jerrolyn Owens and Kelly McLeod. The respondents must electronically file the completed acknowledgment of service of process form upon receipt.

The petitioner is warned that failure to keep the court informed of his current address could also lead to dismissal of his lawsuit.
