ORDER

On October 15, 2010, an order [2] was entered directing Petitioner to file an application to proceed *in forma pauperis* or to pay the \$5.00 filing fee, on or before November 5, 2010. - 1. That Petitioner is granted until and including December 7, 2010, to comply with the Court's order [2] of October 15, 2010, by filing the attached application to proceed *in forma* pauperis in this Court including a current completed certificate portion OR pay the required filing fee of \$5.00.
 - 2. The Clerk shall mail the attached application to proceed in forma pauperis to the

Petitioner at his last known address.

3. That failure of the Petitioner to advise this Court of a change of address or failure to

timely comply with any order of this Court will be deemed as a purposeful delay and

contumacious act by the Petitioner and may result in this cause being dismissed without further

notice to the Petitioner.

4. That the Petitioner is required to file his original response to this order to show cause

with the Clerk, 2012 15th Street, Suite 403, Gulfport, Mississippi 39501. Failure to properly

file a response may result in this civil action being dismissed.
