FINAL JUDGMENT

This matter having come on to be heard on the Motion for Summary Judgment [106] filed by the City of Waveland, Mississippi, the Waveland Board of City and Aldermen, the City of Bay St. Louis, the Bay St. Louis City Council, the Waveland Police Department, David Allen, Mac Cowand, Travis Foreman, H. Bouganim, D. Archer, H. IT IS, FURTHER, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Marlon K. Jackson,

Jr.'s claims against Tamas Filippi and John and Jane Does A-Z are **DISMISSED**
WITHOUT PREJUDICE.
