ORDER

This cause is before the court on the objections of plaintiff Bobby Ingram to the report and recommendation of United States Magistrate Judge John C. Gargiulo on August 3, 2015, recommending that the government's motion to affirm the decision of the commissioner be granted and that plaintiff's motion for summary judgment be denied.
